

Atlanta Men's Workshop Founder Dock Crandell

The Atlanta Men's Workshop was founded by the late Dock Crandell of Roswell, Georgia in 1982. Dock had already started a similar workshop in Germantown, Ohio and wanted to share the miracle of this great weekend with his AA friends in Atlanta. It was one of the many ways that Dock found to "Pass It On!" In the last 25 years since the founding of the Workshop, thousands of men in recovery have attended and grown in their sobriety as a result. Dock never wanted any man to be turned away from the Men's Workshop because he could not afford to go. Dock died in 1985 while on a 12th Step Call, but The Workshop and the dream lives on. Today, it is through the Dock Crandell Memorial Scholarship Fund that we are able to continue to carry the message through scholarships to The Workshop. Many men who have attended on scholarship have returned and helped others to attend. That is the Program in action. Be a part of this grand tradition and make a contribution. There is no screening process and no application to fill out other than the regular registration form on the reverse side. We need to confirm the need and determine the level of help that is needed. We like for the applicant to pay whatever portion of the registration fee that he can afford to pay (minimum of \$25). All scholarships are confidential and no one at The Workshop knows who is on scholarship and who is not.

IF YOU APPLY FOR A WORKSHOP SCHOLARSHIP AND THEN DO NOT SHOW UP, YOUR NAME WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE WORKSHOP MAILING LIST. NO-SHOWS COST US LOTS OF MONEY AND SELFISHLY DEPRIVE OTHER MEN OF ATTENDING WHO WANT TO GO. ALL SCHOLARSHIPS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THIS FORM AND A MINIMUM AMOUNT AS DETERMINED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEEMAN. NO EXCEPTIONS.
